The Juniata County Commissioners met on the above date with Commissioners Jeff Zimmerman, Dale Shelley and Teresa O'Neal present. Also attending were members of the public Robert Kratzer and Ernie Sweitzer, Juniata Sentinel reporter Maria Yohn and Lewistown Sentinel Reporter Micaiah Bilger.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Commissioner Zimmerman. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, the Minutes of the May 25th meeting were approved as submitted.

Sweitzer was present to request information pertaining to the County Employees Retirement Fund under the Right to Know Act. Sweitzer requested the amount of money King Financial Services has received for services rendered since the County invested \$1.8 million in 2000. Sweitzer also requested the Commissioners consider withdrawing those funds in order to protect the principal.

Kratzer was present to express his concerns that information that has been gathered and forwarded to INFOCON for processing is returned but there is no one capable of entering that information into the county's computer. This in turn has caused Kratzer difficulties in performing his duties as sewage enforcement officer. The commissioners agreed the Board needs to investigate and understand the mechanics and issues in the Assessment Office.

The commissioners took the following actions:

- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, ratified Housing Rehab check #219, payable to JOJ Construction in the amount of \$5,500.00.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved HazMat check #1063, payable to Witmer Public Safety Group in the amount of \$234.34.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved checks #29,789 through 29,818 in the amount of \$22,697.36.
- On motion of Shelley/O'Neal and unanimously carried, approved the Rose Consulting Agreement.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved the Statement of Official Absentee Ballots submitted by Voter Registrar Eva Stong.
