

July 13, 2010

The Juniata County Commissioners met on the above date with Commissioners Jeff Zimmerman and Teresa O'Neal present. Commissioner Shelley did not attend for personal reasons. Also attending were Times Reporter Paulette Forry, Juniata Sentinel reporter Maria Yohn, and Lewistown Sentinel Reporter Micaiah Bilger.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Commissioner Zimmerman. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. On motion of O'Neal/Zimmerman, the Minutes of the July 6th meeting were approved as submitted.

The commissioners took the following actions:

- On motion of O'Neal/Zimmerman, ratified CDBG check #1010, payable to William E. Wright in the amount of \$1,600.00 for the Walnut Sewer Project.
- On motion of O'Neal/Zimmerman, approved the Year End HazMat Assessment submitted by Emergency Services Coordinator Allen Weaver.
- On motion of O'Neal/Zimmerman, approved a recommendation from Sheriff Tom Lyter to hire Caryn Baumgardner to fill the vacant Deputy Sheriff position in his office. Her start date will be Monday, July 12th and her salary will be per union contract.
- Acknowledged receipt of the June Monthly Statistical Report submitted by Children & Youth Director Helen Henry.
- On motion of O'Neal/Zimmerman, approved the annual premium from Perry Pest Control for \$300.00 submitted by Maintenance Supervisor Rich Fisher.
- On motion of O'Neal/Zimmerman, approved HazMat check #1068, payable to Sheetz Advantage Card in the amount of \$9.00.
- Contingent upon further review of the bills, on motion of O'Neal/Zimmerman, approved checks #30,084 through 30,000 in the amount of \$7,237.99. O'Neal noted there were checks with no bill documentation and some bills that were paid that were not on the voucher.
- On motion of Zimmerman/O'Neal, approved tax exonerations for Mifflintown Borough.

O'Neal noted an additional individual was working in the Treasurer's Office and questioned what pay arrangements had been made. Zimmerman stated the individual is working on a strictly volunteer basis.
