

March 22, 2011

The Juniata County Commissioners met on the above date with Commissioners Jeff Zimmerman, Dale Shelley and Teresa O'Neal present. Also attending were members of the public Mark Amig, Gary Tweedlie, Justin Seigler, and Bob Reynolds, representing IMR Jim Kinzer, Register and Recorder Alicia Seigler, Deputy Register and Recorder Karen Reichenbach, Times reporter Paulette Forry, Juniata Sentinel reporter Maria Yohn, and Lewistown Sentinel Reporter Micaiah Bilger.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Commissioner Zimmerman. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, the Minutes of the March 15th meeting were approved as submitted.

The commissioners took the following actions:

- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved a recommendation from Seigler to enter into an Agreement with IMR for software in the amount of \$95,880.00.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, ratified CDBG check #1035, payable to Castle Valley Construction in the amount of \$8,037.35 for the Walnut Project.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, ratified a Report of Personnel Transactions for Non-State Employees for Helen Henry, Penni, Abram, Barbara Geedey, Robyn Ventresca, Keith Forry, Susan Clark, Luke Primak, Heather Hockenberry, Karen Imes, Kimberly McKee and Patricia Stong, submitted by Children & Youth Director Helen Henry.
- Acknowledged that Sheriff Lyter has chosen Rick Baubilitz to fill the part-time Deputy position in the Sheriff's office.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved tax exonerations for Greenwood Township.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved the FFY 2008 Citizen Corps Grant in the amount of \$5,500.00
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, ratified checks #926 and #927 and approved checks #31,928 through #31,978 in the amount of \$75,620.22.

O'Neal gave a brief update on NACo's pilot Dental Discount Program which was initiated last year. NACo agreed that Juniata County could be accepted into the Program. The cost of the card will be \$59 for single coverage and \$69 for family. After discussion, the Commissioners agreed to table a decision until they receive additional information.
