The Juniata County Commissioners met on the above date with Commissioners Jeff Zimmerman, Dale Shelley and Teresa O'Neal present. Also attending were – Planning Director Dave Bardell, members of the public Bob Reynolds and Ralph Lotz, Times reporter Paulette Forry, Juniata Sentinel reporter Maria Yohn and Lewistown Sentinel reporter Miciah Bilger.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Commissioner Zimmerman. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, the Minutes of the June 21st meeting were approved as submitted.

The commissioners took the following actions:

- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, ratified CDBG checks –

- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved Ordinance No. 2011-1, the Municipal Solid Waste Ordinance. The Ordinance provides for an update to the County's Solid Waste plan.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved a recommendation from Children & Youth Director Helen Henry to hire Jacqueline Allenbaugh to fill the Caseworker 1 position; a letter to Jacqueline Allenbaugh confirming her transfer from Huntingdon County Children & Youth to Juniata County Children & Youth and a Report of Personnel Transactions for Non-State Employees transferring Jacqueline Allenbaugh from Huntingdon County to Juniata County Children & Youth.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved a Service Agreement with Families First from July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012, submitted by Children & Youth Director Helen Henry.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved checks #32,641 through #32,674 in the amount of \$49,417.36.
