

September 7, 2010

The Juniata County Commissioners met on the above date with Commissioners Jeff Zimmerman, Dale Shelley and Teresa O'Neal present. Also attending were Times Reporter Paulette Forry, Juniata Sentinel reporter Sheila Yorks and Lewistown Sentinel Reporter Micaiah Bilger.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Commissioner Zimmerman. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, the Minutes of the August 31 meeting were approved as submitted.

The commissioners took the following actions:

- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved Proclamation No. 2010-9, proclaiming the week of September 13 – 17, Juniata County Literacy Week.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved Proclamation No. 2010-8, proclaiming the week of September 19 – 25, Child Passenger Safety Week.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved a request from Magisterial District Judge Jackie Leister to transfer \$47.00 from the Bond line item of her 2010 budget to the Subscription line item.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved the Juniata County Integrity Policy.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved a recommendation from the County Improvement Fund Committee to purchase a copier for the District Attorney's office in the amount of \$3,285.00.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved a request from Sheriff Tom Lyter to transfer \$187.50 from the Dues and Subscription line item in his budget, to the Contracted Services line item. Commissioner O'Neal noted the Contracted Services line item is \$2,000 over budget. The issue will be discussed later.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried approved HazMat check #1071, payable to Witmer Public Safety Group in the amount of \$38.50.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved a Purchase of Service Agreement with the Bair Foundation of Pennsylvania submitted by Children & Youth Director Helen Henry.
- On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, approved checks #30,466 through 30,491 in the amount of \$10,528.18
- Acknowledged that Coroner Lee Snyder has appointed The Hudock Law Firm of Mifflinburg, PA, as solicitor for his office. The rate will be \$75.00/ hour and will be used on an as-needed basis. Commissioner Shelley questioned whether the local attorneys had been approached for the position.

On motion of O'Neal/Shelley and unanimously carried, the meeting recessed at 10:15 a.m. and adjourned at 11:00 a.m..
