The Juniata County Commissioners met on the above date with Commissioners Jeff Zimmerman, Robert Reynolds and Teresa O'Neal present. Also attending were Sentinel reporter Julianne Cahill, Juniata Sentinel reporter Maria Yohn, Juniata County Planning Director Brad Kerstetter, Kathy Whitesel representing the Juniata County Workcamp project, Mike Hannon of Tri-County Drug and Alcohol and Marie Mulvihill representing the United Way of Mifflin-Juniata.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Commissioner Zimmerman. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. On a motion by Reynolds a second by O'Neal, the Minutes of the March 25, 2014 meeting were unanimously approved as submitted.

During the public comment period, Mike Hannon expressed an interest in both attending future Board of Commissioners' Meetings and possibly providing updates regarding the Tri-County Drug and Alcohol program.

There being no further public comment, the Commissioners took the following actions:

- It was moved by Reynolds and seconded by O'Neal to approve the floor maintenance proposal from Central PA Commercial Floor Cleaning as submitted by Richard Fisher, Director of Maintenance. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Reynolds and seconded by O'Neal to approve a request for Open Space Legacy Funds for the following municipality:
  - Lack Township \$1,593.20Approval of a similar request from Monroe Township was delayed due to the lack of a project description. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by O'Neal and seconded by Reynolds to ratify the following Juniata County Hazardous Materials checks. The motion was unanimously carried.

  - #1186 \$562.50 Bucks County Community College Classes
- It was moved by O'Neal and seconded by Reynolds to approve checks #39855 - #39891 in the amount of \$130,354.97. The motion was unanimously carried.
- The Commissioners listened to a follow-up presentation by Brad Kerstetter and Kathy Whitesel regarding the Juniata County Workcamp scheduled for June 22nd through June 28th 2014.

There being no further business, it was moved by Reynolds and seconded by O'Neal to adjourn the Board of Commissioners' Meeting at 10:13 a.m. The motion was unanimously carried.
