

April 8, 2014

The Juniata County Commissioners met on the above date with Commissioners Jeff Zimmerman, Robert Reynolds and Teresa O'Neal present. Also attending were Sentinel reporter Julianne Cahill, Juniata Sentinel reporter Maria Yohn and Michael Henry and Robert Zimmerman representing the Juniata County 911 Center.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Commissioner Zimmerman. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. On a motion by Reynolds a second by O'Neal, the Minutes of the April 1, 2014 meeting were unanimously approved as submitted.

There being no public comment, the Commissioners took the following actions:

- It was moved by O'Neal and seconded by Reynolds to approve Proclamation No. 2014-1 proclaiming April 13th through April 19th, 2014 "National Public Safety Telecommunications Week". The motion was unanimously carried.
- The Commissioners reviewed the following March 2014 reports as listed.

- It was moved by Reynolds and seconded by O'Neal to approve requests for Open Space Legacy Funds for the municipalities listed below. The motion was unanimously carried.

 - Tuscarora Township \$2,516.64
- It was moved by O'Neal and seconded by Reynolds to ratify the following Juniata County Hazardous Materials check. The motion was unanimously carried.
 - #1187 \$210.00 Lancaster County Firemen's Assoc. Manuals
- It was moved by O'Neal and seconded by Reynolds to approve the following agreements between Juniata County and the organizations listed as submitted by Allison Fisher, Mifflin-Juniata Human Services Director. The term for each of the contracts is January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014.
 - United Way of Mifflin-Juniata for emergency rent-utility payments for a sum not to exceed \$6,489.00.
 - United Way of Mifflin-Juniata for Service Coordination for a sum not to exceed \$4,108.00.
 - Shelter Services, Inc. for emergency mass shelter for a sum not to exceed \$12,978.00.
 - Mifflin-Juniata Human Services for Service Coordination for a sum not to exceed \$13,937.00.
 - Mifflin-Juniata Human Services for grant administration for a sum not to exceed \$4,167.00.
- It was moved by Reynolds and seconded by O'Neal to approve the tax exonerations for the following municipalities as per the material provided. The motion was unanimously carried.

 - Susquehanna Township
- It was moved by O'Neal and seconded by Reynolds to approve the VOJO (Victims of Juvenile Offenders) grant application - Subgrant 25406 for the period of July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Reynolds and seconded by O'Neal to approve checks #39892 - #39942 in the amount of \$80,736.96. The motion was unanimously carried.

There being no further business, it was moved by Reynolds and seconded by O'Neal to adjourn the Board of Commissioners' Meeting at 10:16 a.m. The motion was unanimously carried.
