

February 11, 2014

The Juniata County Commissioners met on the above date with Commissioners Jeff Zimmerman and Robert Reynolds present. Also attending were Juniata Sentinel reporter Maria Yohn, Sentinel reporter Joe Cannon and Lisa Stalnaker representing Mifflin–Juniata County Human Services.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Commissioner Zimmerman. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. On a motion by Reynolds and a second by Zimmerman, the Minutes of the January 28, 2014 meeting were amended to properly reflect check #39271 as #39371. The motion was unanimously carried. It was then moved by Reynolds and a seconded by Zimmerman to approve the Minutes of the February 4, 2014 meeting as submitted. The motion was unanimously carried.

- It was moved by Reynolds and seconded by Zimmerman to approve the “Emergency Management Performance Grant” application for Federal Fiscal Year 2014 as submitted by Allen Weaver, Emergency Services Director. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Reynolds and seconded by Zimmerman to approve the appointment of Thomas Rhine of 525 Zook Rd., Mifflintown, PA 17059 to a three-year “At Large” Member term on the Juniata County Agricultural Land Preservation Board of Directors effective January 1, 2014. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Reynolds and seconded by Zimmerman to approve checks #39420 - #39463 in the amount of \$68,404.01. The motion was unanimously carried.
