

March 11, 2014

The Juniata County Commissioners met on the above date with Commissioners Jeff Zimmerman, Robert Reynolds and Teresa O'Neal present. Also attending were Sentinel reporter Julianne Cahill, Juniata Sentinel reporter Fonda Henry and Brett Reinford of the Juniata County Farm Bureau.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Commissioner Zimmerman. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. On a motion by Reynolds and a second by O'Neal, the Minutes of the March 4, 2014 meeting were unanimously approved as submitted.

There being no public comment, the Commissioners took the following actions:

- The Commissioners reviewed the following February 2014 reports as listed.

- Commissioner Zimmerman discussed the Juniata County State Health Center immunization outreach project.
- It was moved by O'Neal and seconded by Reynolds to approve the appointment of Alisha Brown to fill the unexpired term of Linda Allen on the Mifflin-Juniata Community Service Block Grant Advisory Board. The term of office is open-ended and will be effective as of the date of the appointment. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by O'Neal and seconded by Reynolds to approve the "County Intermediate Punishment (IP) Funds" grant application for 2014-2015 as submitted by Michelle A. Beaver, Chief Probation Officer. The motion was unanimously carried.
- The Commissioners acknowledged the resignation of David C. Bardell from his position as Associate Planning Director with Juniata County effective at the end of business on March 31, 2014. Chairman Zimmerman, on behalf of the Commissioners, expressed gratitude for Mr. Bardell's service.
- It was moved by Reynolds and seconded by O'Neal to approve checks #39688 - #39745 in the amount of \$110,721.90. The motion was unanimously carried.

There being no further business, it was moved by Reynolds and seconded by Zimmerman to adjourn at 10:06 a. m. The motion passed with Zimmerman and Reynolds voting yes and O'Neal voting no.
