

July 1, 2014

The Juniata County Commissioners met on the above date with Commissioners Jeff Zimmerman, Robert Reynolds and Teresa O'Neal present. Also attending were Sentinel reporter Julianne Cahill, Juniata Sentinel reporter Maria Yohn, Times reporter Paulette Forry, Mifflin–Juniata Human Services Director Allison Fisher, Robert Henry representing Juniata Valley Behavioral and Developmental Services, Nestler Scholarship recipients Courtney Elsasser and Nicholas Gilbert, Abby Ingle representing Juniata County Domestic Relations and Ryan Elsasser .

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Commissioner Zimmerman. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. On a motion by Reynolds and a second by O'Neal, the Minutes of the June 24, 2014 meeting were unanimously approved as submitted.

There being no public comment, the Commissioners took the following actions:

Action regarding final budget approval is scheduled for July 15, 2014.
