The Juniata County Commissioners met on the above date with Commissioners Jeff Zimmerman, Robert Reynolds and Teresa O'Neal present. Also attending were Sentinel reporter Julianne Cahill and Juniata Sentinel reporter Maria Yohn.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Commissioner Zimmerman. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. On a motion by Reynolds and a second by O'Neal, the Minutes of the June 10, 2014 meeting were unanimously approved as submitted.

There being no public comment, the Commissioners took the following actions:

- It was moved by O'Neal and seconded by Reynolds to ratify the County Children & Youth Social Service Programs Certification Statement of receipts and expenditures for July 1, 2013 through March 31, 2014 as prepared by Robyn Ventresca, Children & Youth Fiscal Assistant. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Reynolds and seconded by O'Neal to ratify checks #40451 - #40512 in the amount of \$164,210.98. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by O'Neal and seconded by Reynolds to approve checks #40513 - #40666 in the amount of \$152,240.36. The motion was unanimously carried.
