

March 25, 2014

The Juniata County Commissioners met on the above date with Commissioners Jeff Zimmerman and Robert Reynolds present. Teresa O'Neal participated from a remote location via speakerphone. Also attending were Times reporter Paulette Forry, Juniata Sentinel reporter Maria Yohn, William C. Seigel and Amy Davis representing SEDA-COG, Allen Weaver and William S. Hummel representing Juniata County Emergency Management Services and Fred Boylstein representing PEMA.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Commissioner Zimmerman. Upon calling the meeting to order, Chairman Zimmerman announced that Commissioner O'Neal was participating from a remote location via speakerphone. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. On a motion by Reynolds and a second by O'Neal, the Minutes of the March 18, 2014 meeting were unanimously approved as submitted.

There being no public comment, the Commissioners took the following actions:

- The Commissioners entertained a presentation by Mr. Fred Boylstein of PEMA publically recognizing Allen Weaver and William Hummel for completing their EMA Professional Certifications. All three commissioners offered statements of support.
- It was moved by Reynolds and seconded by O'Neal to approve requests for Open Space Legacy Funds for the following municipalities. The motion was unanimously carried.
  - Delaware Township \$3,139.71
  - Port Royal Borough \$1,877.33
- It was moved by O'Neal and seconded by Reynolds to approve a request to reinstate the Susquehanna Township polling place, commencing with the May 20, 2014 General Primary Election, at the former Susquehanna Township Elementary School located at 2024 Turkey Valley, Rd, Liverpool, PA 17045 as submitted by the Susquehanna Township Board of Supervisors. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Reynolds and seconded by Zimmerman to approve check #39783 in the amount of \$42.08. The motion passed with Zimmerman and Reynolds voting yes. Commissioner O'Neal abstained due to a potential conflict of interest.
- It was moved by Reynolds and seconded by O'Neal to approve checks #39797 - #39854 in the amount of \$79,178.41. The motion was unanimously carried.
- The Commissioners entertained a presentation by Mr. William C. Seigel and Ms. Amy Davis of SEDA-COG regarding the 2014 SEDA-COG Scope of Services.

There being no further business, it was moved by Reynolds and seconded by O'Neal to adjourn at 10:35 a.m. The motion was unanimously carried.
