

The Juniata County Commissioners met on the above date with Commissioners Jeff Zimmerman, Robert Reynolds and Teresa O'Neal present. Also attending were Sentinel reporter Julianne Cahill, Juniata Sentinel reporter Maria Yohn and Juniata County Planning Director Bradley W. Kerstetter.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Commissioner Zimmerman. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. On a motion by O'Neal and a second by Reynolds, the Minutes of the May 13, 2014 meeting were unanimously approved as submitted. On a motion by Reynolds and a second by O'Neal, the Minutes of the special May 13, 2014 meeting were unanimously approved as submitted.

There being no public comment, the Commissioners took the following actions:

- Chairman Zimmerman made mention of the Memorial Day activities throughout the County during the weekend and thanked all involved.
- The Commissioners reviewed the April 2014 Juniata County "Adult & Juvenile Probation Report" as prepared by Michelle A. Beaver, Chief Probation Officer.
- Chairman Zimmerman shared information regarding the Pennsylvania Department of Health immunization clinic.
- It was moved by O'Neal and seconded by Reynolds to approve Sean Gingerich as an unpaid summer intern in the District Attorney's office as recommended by Cory J. Snook, District Attorney. Mr. Gingerich is from Reedsville and recently completed his second year of law school at Roger Williams in Rhode Island. He will work on an as-needed basis through the end of July 2014. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Reynolds and seconded by O'Neal to approve the tax exonerations for Mifflin Borough and Walker Township (with one exception) as per the material provided. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Reynolds and seconded by O'Neal to ratify the following Juniata County Hazardous Materials check. The motion was unanimously carried.

- It was moved by O'Neal and seconded by Reynolds to approve checks #40291 - #40343 in the amount of \$177,441.68. The motion was unanimously carried.
