1. Accept the grant award for "Violence Prevention Programs" funds Subgrant Number 2014/2015-VP-ST-25614.
 2. Approve the "Sub-Recipient Contract Between the Union-Snyder Community Action Agency and the Juniata County Commissioners" for a sum of \$56,668.00 as submitted by Allison Fisher, Human Services Director. The contract period is for January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015.
