The Juniata County Commissioners met on the above date with Commissioners Jeff Zimmerman and Alice Gray present. Teresa O'Neal participated from a remote location via teleconferencing. Also attending were Sentinel reporter Julianne Cahill, Juniata Sentinel reporter Maria Yohn, Times reporter Paulette Forry, Director of Emergency Services Allen Weaver, Community Health Nurse Supervisor Linda L. Allen and Juniata Valley Behavioral & Developmental Services Administrator Chris Wysocki.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Commissioner Zimmerman. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Prior to taking action on the Minutes, Chairman Zimmerman informed the group that Commissioner O'Neal was participating from a remote location via teleconferencing.
