

February 17, 2015

The Juniata County Commissioners met on the above date with Commissioners Jeff Zimmerman and Alice Gray present. Also attending were Sentinel reporter Julianne Cahill, Juniata Sentinel reporter Maria Yohn and Times reporter Paulette Forry.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Commissioner Zimmerman. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. On a motion by Gray and a second by Zimmerman, the Minutes of the February 10, 2015 meeting were unanimously approved as submitted.

There being no public comment, the Commissioners took the following actions:

- The Commissioners reviewed the following January 2015 reports as listed.
  - “Summary of Collections Report – Fines and Costs” as submitted by Jacqueline T. Leister, Magisterial District Judge.
  - Sheriff Department’s “License to Carry” reports as submitted Thomas Lyter, Juniata County Sheriff.
  - “Adult & Juvenile Probation Report” as prepared by Michelle A. Beaver, Chief Probation.
- It was moved by Gray and seconded by Zimmerman to approve the tax exonerations for Milford Township as per the material provided. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Gray and seconded by Zimmerman to ratify the following Juniata County Hazardous Materials check.
  - #1215          \$121.39          Wex Bank          FuelThe motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Gray and seconded by Zimmerman to approve the use of the County Records Improvement Fund to purchase one HP LaserJet Pro 400 M451 DN Printer at a cost of \$539.98 as submitted by S. James Bahorik, County Administrator. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Gray and seconded by Zimmerman to approve the following requests for Liquid Fuel Funds for Thompsontown Borough.
  - \$1,633.59 (2013 Allotment)
  - \$1,633.59 (2014 Allotment)The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Gray and seconded by Zimmerman to approve the contract between SwiftReach Networks and Juniata County for emergency notification services effective as of the date of signing. The agreement period is for 36 months at an annual cost of \$4,495.00. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Gray and seconded by Zimmerman to approve a letter of support endorsing SEDA-COG's intention to apply for a grant from the Appalachian Regional Commission to expand the Regional Gas Utilization Initiative pilot project to the remaining eight SEDA-COG counties (including Juniata County) in addition to a commitment limited to \$5,000 of in-kind services from Juniata County. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Gray and seconded by Zimmerman to approve the following “Purchase of Service Agreement” between Juniata County Children and Youth Services, the Juniata County Probation Department and Diakon Services as prepared and submitted by Robyn Ventresca, Children & Youth Fiscal Assistant. The agreement shall be in force and effect from July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015 inclusive. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Gray and seconded by Zimmerman to approve checks #42436 – 42491 in the amount of \$148,379.31. The motion was unanimously carried.

There being no further business, it was moved by Gray and seconded by Zimmerman to adjourn at 10:10 a.m. The motion was unanimously carried.
