

March 17, 2015

The Juniata County Commissioners met on the above date with Commissioners Jeff Zimmerman, Alice Gray and Teresa O'Neal present. Also attending were Sentinel reporter Julianne Cahill, Juniata Sentinel reporter Maria Yohn, Times reporter Paulette Forry and Juniata County Planning Director Bradley W. Kerstetter.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Commissioner Zimmerman. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. On a motion by O'Neal and a second by Gray, the Minutes of the March 10, 2015 meeting were unanimously approved as submitted.

There being no public comment, the Commissioners took the following actions:

- It was moved by Gray and seconded by O'Neal to adopt Resolution No. 2015-1 "Juniata County 2015 Hazard Vulnerability Assessment and Mitigation Plan Update" as recommended by Bradley W. Kerstetter, planning Director. Mr. Kerstetter provided a status report regarding the Mitigation plan process. The motion was unanimously carried.
- The Commissioners reviewed the following February 2015 report as listed.
 - "Summary of Collections Report – Fines and Costs" as submitted by Jacqueline T. Leister, Magisterial District Judge.
- It was moved by O'Neal and seconded by Gray to ratify the following Juniata County Hazardous Materials check.
 - #1219 \$26.21 Wex Bank FuelThe motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Gray and seconded by O'Neal to approve a request from Mr. Tim Smith to collect recyclable cans from the County offices in support of the "Susquehanna Service Dogs" program. Chairman Zimmerman requested that Mr. Smith provide an annual report reflecting the value of collections as well as the resulting donations made. **Special Notation:** The motion assumes that the County reserves the right to re-evaluate the request at any time. Chairman Zimmerman called for the vote and the motion was unanimously carried.
- **Informational:** No meeting on March 24, 2015 due to the CCAP Spring Conference.
- It was moved by O'Neal and seconded by Gray to approve checks #42602 – #42729 in the amount of \$54,868.46. The motion was unanimously carried.

There being no further business, it was moved by O'Neal and seconded by Gray to adjourn at 10:10 a.m. The motion was unanimously carried.
