

August 23, 2016

The Juniata County Commissioners met on the above date with Commissioners Alice Gray, Todd Graybill and Mark Partner present. Also attending were Sentinel reporter Joe Cannon, Juniata Sentinel reporter Maria Yohn, Times reporter Paulette Forry, President Judge Kathy A. Morrow, County Solicitor Andrew Winder, Daniel Greene representing Seda-Cog and Christine McKelvey, Heather Heckert, Janelle Bryner, Abby Ingle and Vickie Cluck representing the Juniata County Domestic Relations Section.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Chairperson Gray. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. On a motion by Partner and a second by Graybill, the Minutes of the August 16, 2016 meeting were unanimously approved as submitted.

There being no public comment, the Commissioners took the following actions:

- The Commissioners issued Proclamation No. 2016-10 proclaiming August 2016 “Child Support Awareness Month”.
- It was moved by Graybill and seconded by Partner to adopt Ordinance No. 2016-1 “Hotel Room Rental Tax” increasing the funding for tourist promotion activities for Juniata County. The motion was unanimously carried.
- Chairperson Gray recessed the Board of County Commissioners’ Public Meeting and convened the “Final Public Hearing” for the 2016 CDBG Program. Dan Greene of Seda-Cog covered the following items during the hearing.
 - Review of the 2016 CDBG allocation.
 - Review of the approved project activities and funding.
 - Review of a resolution to submit the FFY 2016 CDBG Application.
 - Review of the FFY 2015 Juniata County CDBG Budget Modification.
 - Opportunities for public comments related to the hearing topics.
- Chairperson Gray adjourned the Final Public Hearing and reconvened the Board of County Commissioners’ Public Meeting.
- It was moved by Partner and seconded by Graybill to adopt Resolution 2016-6 authorizing the submission of an application to DCED for Federal Fiscal Year 2016 under the Community Development Block Grant Program and further certifying compliance with program requirements. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Graybill and seconded by Partner to approve the following FFY 2015 Juniata County CDBG Budget Modification. The motion was unanimously carried.

Abram, Children & Youth Director. The term of the agreement is December 27, 2016 to September 30, 2017. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Partner and seconded by Graybill to approve the following requests for Liquid Fuel Funds. The motion was unanimously carried.

- It was moved by Graybill and seconded by Partner to approve the tax exonerations for Mifflin Borough as per the material provided. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Graybill and seconded by Partner to approve the following “Purchase of Service Agreements” between Juniata County Children and Youth Services, the Juniata County Probation Department and the vendors listed. The agreements shall be in force and effect from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016 inclusive. The motion was unanimously carried.

- It was moved by Graybill and seconded by Partner to approve payment of checks #47074 - #47123 in the amount of \$95,720.59. The motion was unanimously carried.
