

May 26, 2015

The Juniata County Commissioners met on the above date with Commissioners Jeffrey Zimmerman, Alice Gray and Teresa O'Neal present. Also attending were Times reporter Paulette Forry and Domestic Relations Director Christine McKelvey.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Chairman Zimmerman. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. On a motion by Gray and a second by O'Neal, the Minutes of the May 12, 2015 meeting were unanimously approved as submitted.

There being no public comment, the Commissioners took the following actions:

- The Commissioners recognized the various Memorial Day events held throughout the County over the weekend. A “thank you” was publically extended to the organizers.
- The Commissioners reviewed the following April 2015 reports as listed.

- It was moved by O'Neal and seconded by Gray to approve a request for Liquid Fuel Funds for Mifflintown Borough in the amount of \$1,272.90. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Gray and seconded by O'Neal to approve the County's annual letter of commitment to the Economic Development Administration activities of SEDA-COG. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by O'Neal and seconded by Gray to approve a change in employment status for Abby R. Ingle to administrative specialist in the Juniata County Domestic Relations Section. The hourly rate will be as per the current bargaining unit contract. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Gray and seconded by O'Neal to ratify the following Juniata County Hazardous Materials check.

- It was moved by O'Neal and seconded by Gray to approve the tax exonerations for Mifflintown Borough and Susquehanna Township as per the material provided. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Gray and seconded by O'Neal to ratify the “Hazardous Materials Emergency Response Service Agreement 2015” as recommended by Allen Weaver, Emergency Services Director. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by O'Neal and seconded by Gray to approve the re-appointment of the following individuals to the Juniata County Library Board of Trustees.

  - Ms. Joan Fulkroad (1938 Long Road, Mifflintown, PA), term expires August 31, 2015. New term will run 9/1/15 - 8/31/18.
  - Ms. Mindy Winder (157 Forge Hill Lane, Mifflintown, PA), term expires October 31, 2015. New term will run 11/1/15 - 10/31/18.The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Gray and seconded by O'Neal to ratify checks #43204 – #43247 in the amount of \$79,659.61. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by O'Neal and seconded by Gray to approve checks #43248 – #43300 in the amount of \$87,576.12. The motion was unanimously carried.
