

January 27, 2015

The Juniata County Commissioners met on the above date with Commissioners Jeff Zimmerman, Alice Gray and Teresa O'Neal present. Also attending were Sentinel reporter Julianne Cahill, Juniata Sentinel reporter Maria Yohn and Mifflin–Juniata Human Services Director Allison Fisher,

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Commissioner Zimmerman. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Prior to voting on the Minutes, Jim Bahorik noted that the January 20<sup>th</sup> Agenda had incorrectly listed Shawn Baumgardner's resignation date as January 11<sup>th</sup> as opposed to the correct date of January 12<sup>th</sup>. Bahorik stated that the Minutes of January 20<sup>th</sup> reflected the corrected date. It was then moved by O'Neal and seconded by Gray to approve the Minutes of the January 20, 2015 meeting as presented. The motion was unanimously approved.

There being no public comment, the Commissioners took the following actions:

- It was moved by Gray and seconded by O'Neal to accept the grant award for "Violence Prevention Programs" funds Subgrant Number 2014/2015-VP-ST-25614. Allison Fisher briefly addressed details regarding the grant. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by O'Neal and seconded by Gray to approve the "Sub-Recipient Contract between the Union-Snyder Community Action Agency and the Juniata County Commissioners" for a sum of \$56,668.00 as submitted by Allison Fisher, Human Services Director. The contract period is for January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015. Allison Fisher provided a brief summary of the agreement. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Gray and seconded by O'Neal to approve the following CSBG contract agreements between Juniata County and the organizations listed as submitted by Allison Fisher, Mifflin-Juniata Human Services Director. Unless otherwise noted, the term for each of the contracts is January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015. Prior to voting, Allison Fisher addressed recent developments with Shelter Services.
  - Shelter Services, Inc. for emergency mass shelter for a sum not to exceed \$6,353.50. The term for this contract is January 1, 2015 through June 30, 2015. The potential exists for the contract to be renewed for an additional \$6,353.50 covering the period of July 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015. If "part two" is renewed, there will be no reapplication process.
  - United Way of Mifflin-Juniata for the Financial Health Project for a sum not to exceed \$10,597.00.
  - Mifflin-Juniata Special Needs Center, Inc. to provide training and transitions (TNT)/community connections for a sum not to exceed \$16,000.00.
  - Mifflin-Juniata Human Services for housing stability case management for a sum not to exceed \$12,506.00.
  - Mifflin-Juniata Human Services for grant administration for a sum not to exceed \$5,756.00.The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by O'Neal and seconded by Gray to ratify the following CDBG Home Housing Rehab Project check as submitted by the Juniata County Planning Department.
  - #266 \$4,105.00 SEDA-COG DeliveryThe motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Gray and seconded by O'Neal to approve checks #42281 – 42325 in the amount of \$119,739.71. The motion was unanimously carried.

There being no further business, it was moved by O'Neal and seconded by Gray to adjourn at 10:18 a.m. The motion was unanimously carried.
