

September 27, 2016

The Juniata County Commissioners met on the above date with Commissioners Alice Gray, Todd Graybill and Mark Partner present. Also attending were Sentinel reporter Joe Cannon, Times reporter Paulette Forry, Juniata Sentinel report Maria Yohn, Sheriff H. Thomas Lyter, Doug Cramer and Kristin Wagner representing the Abuse Network and Christy Nevel representing Juniata Valley Behavioral and Developmental Services.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Chairperson Gray. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. On a motion by Graybill and a second by Partner, the Minutes of the September 20, 2016 meeting were unanimously approved as submitted.

There being no public comment, the Commissioners took the following actions:

- The Commissioners recognized Christy Nevel for her nomination to the PA Early Learning Policy Fellowship.
- The Commissioners issued Proclamation No. 2016-13 “Domestic Violence Awareness Month 2016”.
- It was moved by Graybill and seconded by Partner to approve an agreement between Infocon Corporation and Juniata County covering document scanning services for the Register and Recorders office as recommended by Alicia Seigler, Register and Recorder. The estimated fee for the project is \$3,914.67. The motion was unanimously carried.
- The commissioners reviewed the “Children & Youth Services Expenditure Reports” for the periods January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015 and January 1, 2016 thru March 31, 2016 as submitted by Helen Britcher, Children & Youth Fiscal Assistant.
- It was moved by Partner and seconded by Graybill to approve the “Certification Statement” of receipts and expenditures for the period of April 1, 2016 through June 30, 2016 as submitted by Helen M. Britcher, Children & Youth Fiscal Assistant. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Partner and seconded by Graybill to approve the purchase of a HI-SCAN 6040ds Heimann X-RAY security device for a sum of \$24,080.33 as recommended by H. Thomas Lyter, Sheriff. A majority of the funding for the purchase will be available via grant monies from the Administrative Office of Pennsylvania Courts (AOPC). The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Graybill and seconded by Partner to approve payment of checks #47396 - #47440 in the amount of \$108,276.76. The motion was unanimously carried.

There being no further business, it was moved by Graybill and seconded by Partner to adjourn at 10:14 a.m. The motion was unanimously carried.
