

July 28, 2015

The Juniata County Commissioners met on the above date with Commissioners Jeff Zimmerman, Alice Gray and Teresa O'Neal present. Also attending were Juniata Sentinel reporter Maria Yohn.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Chairman Zimmerman. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. On a motion by Gray and a second by O'Neal, the Minutes of the July 21, 2015 meeting were unanimously approved as submitted.

There being no public comment, the Commissioners took the following actions:

- It was moved by Gray and seconded by O'Neal to approve the transfer of a Ricoh copier lease agreement from Magisterial District Judge, Jacqueline Leister - #41-3-02 to Juniata County Children & Youth Services. The terms of the Ricoh USA, Inc. lease are for 60 months at \$150.00 per quarter with an effective starting date of November 24, 2014. The actual copier will be moved to its new location at a time that is convenient for the departments in question. The motion was unanimously carried.
- **\*Information Only:** There will not be a meeting on August 4, 2015.
- It was moved by Gray and seconded by O'Neal to approve Franklin Fortney to assume temporary full-time status in the Juniata County Probation Department during the time that Probation employee Chris Tate participates in training for the PA National Guard. The duration of this change in status will be approximately August 31 through mid-December 2015. **This will be a temporary full-time status and will not alter his original hiring contract.** The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by O'Neal and seconded by Gray to approve checks #43780 - #43808 in the amount of \$326,826.66. The motion was unanimously carried.

There being no further business, it was moved by Gray and seconded by O'Neal to adjourn at 10:02 a.m. The motion was unanimously carried.
