

June 30, 2015

The Juniata County Commissioners met on the above date with Commissioners Jeff Zimmerman, Alice Gray present. Also attending were Times reporter Paulette Forry, Lewistown Sentinel reporter Julianne Cahill, Juniata Sentinel reporter Maria Yohn, Mifflin Juniata Human Services Director, Allison L. Fisher, Tri-County Drug and Alcohol representative Mike Hannon, and Bill Seigel and Dan Greene representing SEDA COG.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Chairman Zimmerman. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. On a motion by Gray and a second by Zimmerman, the Minutes of the June 23, 2015 meeting were unanimously approved as submitted.

There being no public comment, the Commissioners took the following actions:

- It was moved by Gray and second by Zimmerman to approve Ms. Samantha Gray and Mr. Andrew Reid as unpaid interns with the Juniata County Probation Office as submitted by Michelle A. Beaver, Chief Probation Officer. Ms. Gray's internship will begin on July 6, 2015 and last for 50 hours. Mr. Reid will begin his internship on August 24, 2015 and is scheduled to finish December 11, 2015. Prior to the vote, Commissioner Gray expressed concerns about Ms. Samantha Gray being a high school student and how that may affect matters of confidentiality. Chairman Zimmerman echoed Gray's concerns. It was mutually decided that the situation warranted monitoring. Chairman Zimmerman then called for the vote and the motion was unanimously carried.
- Alison L. Fisher conducted a hearing on the Annual Human Services Non-Block Grant budget.
- It was moved by Gray and seconded by Zimmerman to approve the Fiscal Year 2015-2016 "HSDF Assurance of Compliance" as submitted by Allison L. Fisher, Human Services Director. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Gray and seconded by Zimmerman to approve the following annual Human Services Development Fund Contracts between the Juniata County Commissioners and the entities listed as recommended by Allison L. Fisher, Human Services Director. The Term of each contract is July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016.
 - Juniata County Probation and Parole for Coordinated Individual Therapy & Evaluation Services - \$3,420.00.
 - Big Brothers Big Sisters of Juniata Valley for Mentoring Services - \$2,000.00
 - Clear Concepts Counseling for Drug and Alcohol Counseling Services - \$6,500.00
 - Shelter Services, Inc. for Emergency Shelter Services - \$5,040.00
 - Mifflin Juniata Dental Clinic for Dental Outreach Services – \$3,293.00
 - Abuse Network, Inc. for Case Management - \$3,000.00
 - Mifflin Juniata Human Services for Service Coordination - \$21,747.00
 - Mifflin Juniata Human Services for County Administration - \$5,000.00The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Gray and seconded by Zimmerman to approve the following Homeless Assistance Program contracts as submitted by Allison L. Fisher, Human Services Director. The terms of each of the contracts are from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016.
 - Administrative Services at a total cost of \$1,909.00.
 - Rental/Utility Assistance Services at a total cost of \$2,000.00.
 - Case Management Services at a total cost of \$15,188.00.The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Gray and seconded by Zimmerman to approve a request for Liquid Fuel Funds for Turbett Township in the amount of \$606.90. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Gray and seconded by Zimmerman to approve a letter of support for the Chesapeake Bay Foundation's Growing Greener Plus grant entitled *Incentives for Forested Buffers and Agricultural Conservation in Juniata and Mifflin Counties* within the Chesapeake Bay Watershed. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Gray and seconded by Zimmerman to approve checks #43500 - #43549 in the amount of \$65,891.27. The motion was unanimously carried.
- It was moved by Gray and seconded by Zimmerman to ratify the following Juniata County Hazardous Materials check.
 - #1229 \$6,529.78 New Pig Corporation Absorbent MaterialsThe motion was unanimously carried.
- The commissioners entertained a presentation by Mr. Bill Seigel of SEDA COG introducing Mr. Dan Greene to the commissioners and to give updates on the CDBG Grant Program.

There being no further business, it was moved by Gray and seconded by Zimmerman to adjourn at 11:07 a.m. The motion was unanimously carried.
