

September 9, 2014

The Juniata County Commissioners met on the above date with Commissioners Jeff Zimmerman and Teresa O’Neal present. Also attending were Sentinel reporter Julianne Cahill, Times reporter Paulette Forry and Juniata Sentinel reporter Carol Smith.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Commissioner Zimmerman. A moment of silence was observed followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. On a motion by O’Neal and a second by Zimmerman, the Minutes of the September 2, 2014 meeting were unanimously approved as submitted.

There being no public comment, the Commissioners took the following actions:

- It was moved by O’Neal and seconded by Zimmerman to approve checks #41116 – 41144 in the amount of \$10,971.53. The motion was unanimously carried.
